Served with 35 Sqn RAAF.

To 5 Sqn.

Crashed while trying to rescue a suspected snake bitten soldier from High Range training area at night 20/04/77.

Crew were pilots Ken Webb, and Noddy Sawade while crewies were Ted Maxwell, all 35 Squadron.

Aircraft written off by the RAAF, however Bell Helicopters at Eagle Farm repaired it and handed it back to the RAAF 16/03/1978.

Several tours with Peace Monitoring Group, Bougainville, since 04/98.

Transferred to Army Aviation 12/89-01/90

Served with 171 Sqn - 1st Aviation Regiment.

Retired and placed into storage.

Delivered to Scottsdale RSL in Tasmania 30/09/2014
